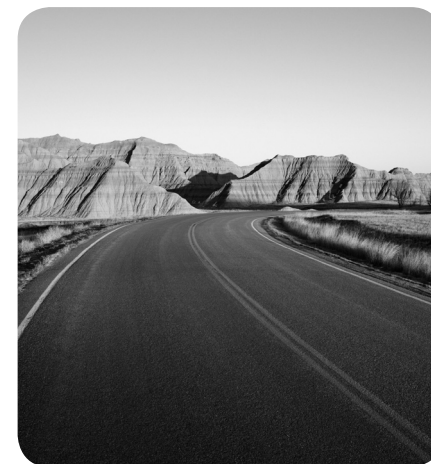

Monday, July 23: Step back in time with Utopia Tours on this tour that takes us west into the Black Hills, Cody, Yellowstone and Medora for some great summer fun. Bring your family and friends along. Today we will go as far as WALL, SOUTH DAKOTA. This evening we will go to the famous WALL DRUG for an INCLUDED MEAL as we get to know our fellow travelers.

Tuesday, July 24: About an hour from Wall, we arrive in Rapid City, South Dakota. Here we will visit a replica of an 850 year old church in Norway at the STAVKIRKE CHAPEL IN THE HILLS. You will appreciate the serene setting as we tour the area. Then continue to MOUNT RUSHMORE. The faces of former presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln, are carved into the mountain. This enormous project took 14 years to complete, ending in 1941. After spending some time in this area we will go on to Deadwood, South Dakota for the night. Evening is free to enjoy the sights and casino's of Deadwood.

Wednesday, July 25: As we leave Deadwood this morning we will enjoy a scenic drive through Spearfish Canyon to Spearfish where we will catch back on to I90 and continue west to Sheridan, Wyoming and then cross the BIGHORN MOUNTAINS to CODY, WYOMING. Here we will visit the BUFFALO BILL MUSEUM and enjoy an included meal at the famous IRMA'S RESTAURANT. This evening we will attend the RODEO held every night here in Cody.

Thursday, July 26: Soon after we leave Cody this morning we will travel through the beautiful SHOSHONE NATIONAL FOREST on our way in to YELLOWSTONE NATIONAL PARK. Our first stop in the Park will be at FISHING BRIDGE. We will also see the GRAND YELLOWSTONE LAKE and spend time at OLD FAITHFUL, seeing the geyser spout into the air as it has for many years. We will spend the night in WEST YELLOWSTONE. Evening on own.

Friday, July 27: We will spend a little more time in Yellowstone traveling up to MAMMOTH HOT SPRINGS, etc. Then back to West Yellowstone and travel down the Gallatin Canyon to Bozeman, Montana. Our lodging for the night will be in BILLINGS, MONTANA.

Saturday, July 28: Continuing on I90 through Miles City and Glendive, Montana we will arrive in MEDORA, NORTH DAKOTA. We will have a little free time in Medora and then this evening enjoy an included PITCHFORK FONDUE and the evening MEDORA MUSICAL which is nestled in the hillside and overlooking the valley. The night will be spent here in MEDORA.
