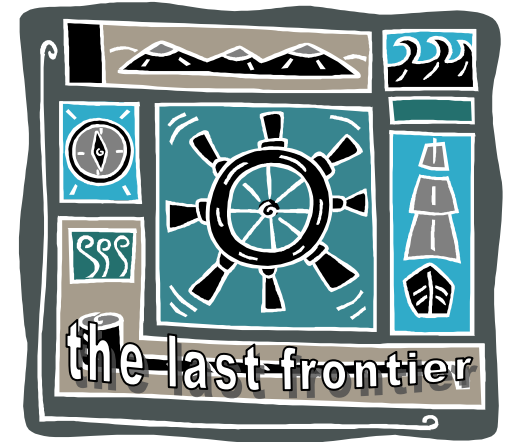

Fri., July 23: **Minneapolis, MN ~ Minneapolis, MN**, is our destination as we anxiously await our flight to Alaska Saturday.

Sat., July 24: **Anchorage, AK (D)** ~ We board our **flight from Minneapolis, MN, to Anchorage, AK**. In Anchorage tonight we get together for an **included meal at the Sour Dough Mining Company**. Anchorage is Alaska's largest city and is located on the shores of the Cook Inlet, Anchorage is the center for trade, finance, and culture in Alaska. Learn about the 1964 earthquake, see Lake Hood, the World's largest seaplane base, and about the history of Captain James Cook in 1778, as we **tour the city**.

Sun., July 25: **Denali, AK (CB)** ~ From Anchorage we start our way north, taking us deeper into Alaska. Along the way we will stop in **Wasilla, AK**, at the **Iditarod Trail Headquarters** to learn of the annual Anchorage to Nome Dog Sled Race. We will stop at the **McKinley Wilderness Lodge** this afternoon, and then continue on to **Denali, AK**, for our lodging.

Mon., July 26: **Fairbanks, AK (CB, L)** ~ We journey into **Denali National Park** today. Denali means "the Great One," and this is the second largest of our national parks. **Mount McKinley**, which sits here on the horizon, is the highest point in North America. In the Park we take a **wildlife tour** deep into the wilderness with a **box meal included**. From here we go north through **Nenana** to **Fairbanks, AK**, where we will stay for the next **two nights**.

Tues., July 27: **Fairbanks, AK (CB, D)** ~ A great day awaits us as we start out aboard the **Riverboat Discovery** for an unforgettable cruise aboard an authentic sternwheeler. During our **narrated cruise on the Chena and Tenana Rivers** we'll view the "wedding of the rivers," step ashore at the Old Chena Indian Village, experience an Athabaskan fish camp, see and hear about sled dogs at Susan Butcher's Camp, and more. Then we **pan for gold at the El Dorado Gold Mine**. The day ends with a delicious **Salmon Bake** (serving salmon, halibut, and cod). Enjoy a second night here in **Fairbanks**.

Wed., July 28: **Valdez, AK (CB)** ~ One of the most scenic drives in Alaska awaits us today. A stop will be made at **Rika's Roadhouse**; see the **Alaska Pipeline**, beautiful **Bridal Veil Falls, Worthington Glacier**; and, view **Thompson Pass**, and more as we follow the **Richardson Highway to Valdez, AK**. Valdez is located off the Prince William Sound and the shores of the Gulf of Alaska. A beautiful place to spend the night.

Thurs., July 29: **Valdez, AK (CB, L)** ~ Here in Valdez we will take off for a **cruise along the Prince William Sound**. Enjoy the scenery, wildlife, and narration, plus an **included lunch** while cruising. We spend a second night back in **Valdez** - home of the Aleyska Pipeline Terminal.
