CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: Receive a 100% refund when canceling, for any reason, up to final payment due date. Wed., Sept. 15: Wall, SD

Step back in time with Utopia Tours on this tour that takes us into South Dakota, highlighting Deadwood and the Black Hills. Today we go as far as **Wall, SD**. A stop will be made at the famous **Wall Drug** tonight for dinner on your own.

Thurs., Sept. 16: Deadwood, SD (CB)

About an hour from Wall we arrive in Rapid City, SD. Here we visit a replica of an 850-year old church in Norway at the **Stavkirke Chapel in the Hills**. You will appreciate the serene setting as we tour the area. Then continue on routing through Sturgis to **Spearfish, SD**. The **Black Hills** surround us as we drive through the beautiful **Spearfish Canyon**. Then go on down to **Deadwood, SD**. Deadwood is located amongst the Black Hills. Wild West legends, like Wild Bill Hickok, Wyatt Earp, and Calamity Jane, were made famous here in this rustic town. Upon arrival we will visit the **Mount Moriah Cemetery** where Wild Bill Hickok and Calamity Jane are buried. Later we will see a wild west re-enactment of a historical gunfight by the **Deadwood Gunslingers**. The evening is free to enjoy on your own exploring more of the town, or trying your luck at one of the 80 casinos in the **Deadwood, SD**, area.

Fri., Sept. 17: Deadwood, SD (CB)

Sightseeing awaits us today as we head out of Deadwood on #385 this morning. We will explore America's most famous mountain-**Mt. Rushmore**. The faces of former presidents George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln are carved into the mountain. This enormous project ended in 1941, and took 14 years to complete. Enjoy time at **Keystone** and at the **Borglund Historical Center**, which tells more about the man who started carving this Mt. Rushmore. Then we depart for **Custer State Park** which covers 71,000 acres. See lakes, streams, wildlife, and more as we roll along. Then head north and to view the **Crazy Horse Memorial** on our way back to Deadwood. Your on your own tonight to experience more of **Deadwood**.

Sat., Sept. 18: Mitchell, SD (CB, D)

Later morning we will depart Deadwood and go on to Chamberlain, SD. A stop is made at the **Lewis & Clark Information Center** while here. Then on to **Mitchell, SD**. We are including a visit to the **Mitchell Corn Palace**, which is decorated each year with a different theme from area harvests. Our stay is here in Mitchell, SD, with a **meal** included this evening.

Sun., Sept. 19: Home (CB)

Homeward bound today after exploring through the Black Hills and learning more about the history of Deadwood. We arrive home this afternoon. Thank you for traveling with Utopia Tours.
