CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: Receive a 100% refund when canceling, for any reason, up to final payment due date. Tues., Aug. 17: Winnipeg, MB

Join Utopia Tours as we travel to the Jasper and Banff National Parks, and the amazing Canadian Rockies. Our travels today take us through North Dakota and up into **Winnipeg, MB**, where we will stay tonight. Winnipeg is the capital of Manitoba.

Wed., Aug. 18: Saskatoon, SK (CB)

Our journey has us traveling west on the Yellowhead Highway through Canada to **Saskatoon, SK**. Seven river crossings give this town the nickname "Bridge City." It is relatively flat in this area, compared to the Rockies we will soon be in.

Thurs., Aug. 19: Edmonton, AB (CB)

We drive through oil and cattle country with a stop for dinner in **Lloydminster**. Our destination is **Edmonton, AB**. Spend some time at the huge **West Edmonton Mega Mall**, which has over 800 stores and services, over 100 eating establishments, and 9 World-Class Parks and Attractions this afternoon.

Fri., Aug. 20: Jasper, AB (CB)

The **Canadian Rockies** begin to surround us as we get closer to **Jasper, AB**. Wildlife is abundant here, as is the beautiful scenery. A **scenic cruise on Maligne Lake** among the majestic glaciers and peaked mountains alive with wildlife and nature is a highlight of this tour. We spend the night in Jasper, AB, located in **Jasper National Park**.

Sat., Aug. 21: Banff, AB (CB)

The awesome scenery continues as we make our way southeast through the Rocky Mountains. Part of the experience of this area is the **Columbia Icefields**. We will board **all-terrain Ice Explorers** that will take us out onto the **Athabasca Glacier** and more. This Icefield is one of the largest accumulations of ice and snow south of the Arctic Circle. Then on to **Banff, AB**, for a **two-night stay**.

Sun., Aug. 22: Banff, AB (CB)

A trip through Alberta would not be complete without a stop at the **Chateau Lake Louise**. While at the Chateau this morning, enjoy the surrounding mountains and the view of the **Victoria Glacier** as it reflects off Lake Louise. Truly breathtaking. We will also drive through a portion of **Yoho National Park**. More exploring as we view the **Bow Falls** back in Banff. You may wish (on your own) to take the 8-minute ride to the top of Sulphur Mountain. At the top you could dine at the Panoramic Restaurants. The evening is yours to enjoy on your own.

Mon., Aug. 23: Shelby, MT (CB)

Departing the Rockies we travel through **Calgary, AB**, home of the Calgary Stampede & Rodeo that is held in July. Then on through the southeast corner of Alberta and into Montana. Our destination is **Shelby, MT**, where we will stay for the night.

Tues., Aug. 24: Medora, ND (CB, D)

From Shelby we travel over to **Medora, ND**, located in the **North Dakota Badlands**. After arriving this evening we will enjoy the delicious **Pitchfork Steak Fondue**, held outdoors overlooking the scenic Tjaden Terrace. Then over to the **Medora Musical** for a wonderful show, which retells history and includes talented performers and musicians.

Wed., Aug. 25: Home (CB)

Homeward bound today routing through Fargo and back into Minnesota. We hope you enjoyed this Canadian Rockies Tour, seeing the big cities and quaint towns, glaciers, mountains, valleys, lakes, wildlife, and awesome beauty it provides. We arrive home this evening.
