CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS: Receive a 100% refund when canceling, for any reason, up to final payment due date. After final payment due date (listed on individual brochure) and up to 7 business days prior to departure receive 75%, less non-recoverable fees; this is for medical reasons only, need note from doctor. 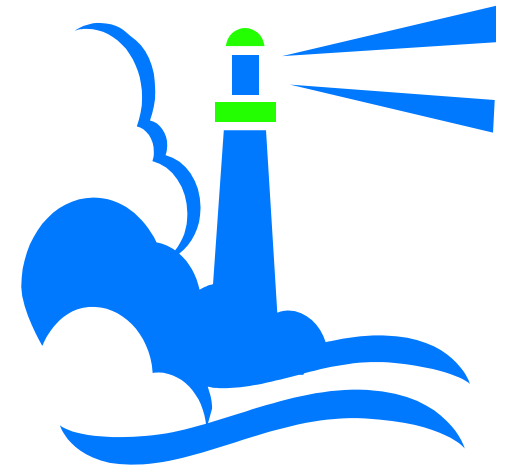

Tues., Sept. 28: Green Bay, WI

We depart today on a tour familiarizing ourselves with the “Cape Cod of the Midwest” - Door County. Next, a delicious **lunch** is included at **Al Johnson’s Swedish Restaurant** in Sister Bay. Al Johnson’s restaurant is a sod-roofed Swedish restaurant built into the earth that serves wonderful food. Goats and other animals are able to graze on its sod roof. Then venture out to do some sightseeing, including a stops at the **Bjorklunden Chapel** and the **Door Peninsula Winery**. We will have dinner, on your own, in **Ephraim** prior to checking in to our lodging. Our lodging is located in **Sister Bay, WI**, for **two nights**. Relax during our free evening here in Ellison Bay.

Thurs., Sept. 30: Sister Bay, WI (CB, L, D)

A **breakfast** is included at the Resort to get us started. We will then go to the tip of Door County to board a **ferry** out to **Washington Island**. Enjoy the 15-mile **Cherry Train Tour** and **included lunch** on the Island. Learn about the history, folklore, and legends of island life during this tour. Later, we return by **ferry** to the mainland. Then enjoy some time to explore and shop in **Egg Harbor and Fish Creek**. Tonight is a treat as we take in Door County’s traditional **Fish Boil Buffet**. At the Fish Boil you are able to see how they boil whitefish the old-fashioned way. A meal complete with all the sides and a delicious dessert.
