Enjoy your free time this evening for a meal (on your own) explore the Island, stroll the picturesque streets, and visit the shops known for their scrumptious fudge.

Tues., Aug. 10: Ashland, WI • Apostle Islands (CB) ~ We return to the mainland by ferry this morning and reboard our motorcoach. Then we cross the "Mighty Mac," the 5-mile long **Mackinac Bridge** to **St. Ignace, MI**, then head to **Ashland, WI**, where we will stay for the night.

Wed., Aug. 11: Home (CB) ~ A short drive takes us to Bayfield, WI, this morning to board a **3-hour Grand Tour cruise through the Apostle Islands**. This non-stop **narrated cruise** travels 55 miles past 22 Apostle Islands and views Raspberry and Devils Island Lighthouses as well as the Devils Island sea caves. We then return home traveling through Wisconsin making the comfort stops along the way.
