**Sat., Sept. 25: Escanaba, MI**

We will depart this morning on a beautiful fall color trip to northeast Canada and US. We will make our necessary meal stops and then on to **Escanaba, MI**, for the night.

**Sun., Sept. 26: Sudbury, ON (CB)**

As we leave this morning we will drive through the Hiawatha National Forest along Lake Michigan to the "City of Locks"-**Sault Ste. Marie**, which is connected by bridges with its sister city in Ontario. We will stop at the **Soo Locks** to observe ships being raised and lowered to bypass St. Mary's Rapids, and spend time at the **Visitor's Center**. We will then go on to **Sudbury, Ontario**, for the night.

**Mon., Sept. 27: Ottawa, ON (CB)**

**Ottawa, ON**, the capital of Canada, is our destination today. We arrive with time to enjoy a **city tour** in the afternoon. Ottawa was chosen to be the capital of the country because it was here the English and French culture came together. It is one of Canada's most beautiful cities. While on our tour we will see **Parliament Hill, Embassy Row, the Prime Minister's Residence, Rideau Canal** and more.

**Tues., Sept. 28: Montreal, PQ (CB)**

Today we will drive through the scenic Laurentian Highlands on our way to **Montreal**, an important trading center for over 300 years. A **local guide** will provide a **tour of the city** including **St. Joseph's Oratory, Olympia Park**-the site of Expo '67.

**Wed., Sept. 29: Quebec, PQ (CB)**

The city of **Quebec** welcomes us today. Its old stone buildings, horse-drawn carriages, steep winding streets and ancient trees all add to its charm. Our first stop will be a visit to the **Basilica of Sainte-Anne-de-Beaupre**. The first chapel was built here in 1658. After a stop at

**Montmorency Falls** we will pick up our **guide** for a **city tour** to learn of the history of the city and see how it is divided into the Upper Town and Lower Town. During our tour we will see the **Citadel, Chateau Frontenac, Plains of Abraham**, and more. This evening you may choose to visit the famous Artists Alley and eat in Old Town.

**Thurs., Sept. 30: Fredericton, NB (CB)**

As we journey through the Province of Quebec, we will drive along the **St. Lawrence River** and then enter the Province of New Brunswick with dinner at Edmundston (on own). We will make a stop at the **World's longest Covered Bridge in Hartland** and spend the night in **Fredericton, NB**.

**Fri., Oct. 1: Charlottetown, PEI (CB)**

A short ride will bring us to **Saint John**, located on the **Bay of Fundy**. St. John claims one of the finest and busiest harbors along the Atlantic seaboard. Here we will stop at the **Reversing Falls Rapids**, where the flow of the St. John River is dramatically reversed by the ocean tide. Our next stop will be Moncton with a visit to **Magnetic Hill**. We will then drive to Cape Tormentine, NB, where we take the 9-mile Bridge to **Prince Edward Island**, overnighting in **Charlottetown**-the provincial capitol.

**Sat., Oct. 2: Cape Breton Isl/Baddeck, NS (CB)**

The smallest province, Prince Edward Island is also known as "the birthplace of Canada" because the Conference of Confederation was held here in 1864. A **guide** will join us this morning for an interesting **tour** of this charming island. We will stop at the humble cottage immortalized in the novel **Anne of Green Gables**. We will travel by **ferry** this afternoon from Prince Edward Island to **Nova Scotia** and then continue by motorcoach to **Cape Breton Island** with our lodging at **Baddeck for the next two nights**.

**Sun., Oct. 3: Baddeck, NS (CB)**

We will view the Cape Breton Highlands today while on a full-day guided tour. Enjoy the 184-mile drive on the **Cabot Trail**, named for explorer John Cabot, around Cape Breton Island. This afternoon a stop will be made at the **Alexander Graham Bell Museum**, which contains the largest collection of Bell's artifacts and inventions. After the tour we will return to **Baddeck** for the night.

**Mon., Oct. 4: Halifax, NS (CB, D)**

We will drive to **Halifax** today, whose history dates back to its founding in 1749. Halifax is the provincial capital of Nova Scotia and is a busy commercial center where much has been done to preserve the historic and natural heritage. We will spend some time sightseeing and this evening enjoy time in **Peggy's Cove, NS**, which is one of the most photographed and painted areas in all of North America. Peggy's Cove is a quaint and picturesque fishing village where lobster fishermen live and work. Enjoy an included **lobster dinner** here.

**Tues., Oct. 5: St John, NB (CB)**

This morning we depart Halifax following the **Evangeline Trail** past fertile farmlands of the Annapolis Valley. At **Grand Pre National Park** we will learn of the deportation of the French Acadians, who are forever immortalized in Longfellow's "Evangeline." The Acadians made their home here until they were expelled in 1775 for refusing to swear allegiance to England. We will continue to **Digby, NS**, known as the scallop capital, for lunch on your own. From Digby we board our **ferry** to take us across the **Bay of Fundy to St John, NB**. During our 3-hour cruise you may wish to dine at one of their two restaurants, visit the gift shop, or relax and enjoy the views. Our overnight is here in **Saint John, NB**.

**Wed., Oct. 6: Bar Harbor, ME (CB)**

We wind our way along the Atlantic coastline to **Bar Harbor**, which was once an exclusive playground of American millionaires. A visit to the **Acadia National Park Visitor's Center** is included.

**Thurs., Oct. 7: Franconia, NH (CB)**

A scenic drive awaits us today as we route along the coastline through Maine and into New Hampshire. Here, the scenic **Kancamagus Highway**, known as one of the most scenic routes in the region, will take us through the **White Mountains to Lincoln, NH**, nestled in the Loon Mountain Range. A short drive takes us to **Franconia, NH**, our home for the night.

**Fri., Oct. 8: Binghamton, NY (CB)**

The scenery changes throughout the day as we leave the White Mountains of Vermont on our way to Binghamton, NY. A coffee stop will be made in **Bath, NH**. Bath is home of the Brick Store, a general store that dates back to as far as 1790. Then on to the Lebanon, NH, and White River Junction, VT, area. From White River Junction we travel across Vermont and the Green Mountains to Glens Falls, NY. Soon, we get on to I-88 taking us to **Binghamton, NY**, where we will stay for the night.

**Sat., Oct. 9: Toledo, OH (CB)**

**Toledo, OH**, is our destination today. Enjoy the driving time as we pass through Pennsylvania and into Ohio following the shores of Lake Erie. Enjoy the night here in **Toledo, OH, area**.

**Sun., Oct. 10:**

**Nappanee, IN/Rockford, IL (CB, L)**

We continue our journey home today. In the Amish Country of **Nappanee, IN**, we will make an **included lunch stop at Amish Acres**. After lunch and time to explore the area we board our motorcoach for a relaxing ride to **Rockford, IL**.

**Mon., Oct. 11: Home (CB)**

Homeward bound today, reminiscing about the scenic wonders and amazing history of the areas of the northeast. We arrive home early afternoon. Thank you for traveling with Utopia Tours.
